- Submit **an abstract of 250-300 words.**
- Only abstracts of completed studies (i.e., with results already) will be accepted.
- To facilitate the grouping of abstracts, indicate which among the themes listed above does the study fall under.
- Email the abstract to cgster@pnu.edu.ph with the subject heading **I-CEARE: SURNAME** (e.g., I-CEARE: DELA CRUZ).

How to go to Boracay Island

1. Take domestic flights to Caticlan (Godofredo Ramos Airport). Participants should take airbuses rather than small aircrafts (Philippine Airlines have airbuses). NAIA 3 and NAIA 4 (Terminal 3 and 4) are the airports going to Caticlan. For transfer to Terminal 3 or 4, inquire at the information center of the airport or crews if you travel via Philippine Airlines from abroad, they will arrange your transfer to domestic terminals.
2. There are hotel transfer services available at the Godofredo Ramos Airport (Caticlan). Transfer services include: airport to pier/port, boat trip to Boracay Island, Boracay port to hotel. Transfer fees may range from 500 pesos-600 one way (11-13 USD). The hotel will be announce later.

How to travel to Boracay Island

1. Travel light. We suggest that you limit your baggage to one.
2. Light cotton clothes, flat shoes and rubber shoes will make you comfortable during your travel.
3. In case you have a number of luggages, you can make arrangements with porters.

Temperature in Boracay in May: Generally about 32 degrees
